<b>Subject(s)</b>	Math Counting

<b>Suggested Time</b>	15 Minutes
<b>Objectives</b>	Students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Learn Counting and have fun all at the same time!...</li> <li>2. <b>Materials</b>	A baggie or a 'fun-size' bag of M&M's for each child A Work Sheet for each child (unless you are working in groups)
<b>Preparation</b>	The paper. You can make up questions (here are a few of the from my work sheet) G=Green B=Blue R=Red Y=Yellow DB=Dark Brown O=Orange <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. With out opening you bag guess how many M&amp;M's are in your bag?</li> <li>2. Now open your bag How many are really in there?</li> <li>3. How many M&amp;M's were you off by?</li> <li>4. Put in groups. How many of each group are there? Green=_____ Blue=_____ Red=_____ Yellow=_____ Bark Brown=_____</li> <li>Orange=_____</li> <li>5. Now take 15 of the M&amp;M's and put them in a pile.</li> </ul>
<b>Motivation</b>	They will have a reward at the end of this lesson. Or you can tell them at the beginning of the week "if you are good we will do a fun project on (choose a day) this week!
<b>Conclusion</b>	They can share their answers because none (or most of them) will not have the same answers.
