

Title Math by M&M's	
Overview	This is a lesson about counting adding and subtracting. You will to have a random number (20-30) of M&M's in a bag or just a funsize bag and have the children do it themselves. It is simple.

Grade Level(s)	Pre-School Kindergarten Grade 1 Grade 2
Suggested Time	15 Minutes
Objectives	<p>Students will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Learn Counting and have fun all at the same time!... 2. They also Learn subtraction and adding at as young as you want! 3. They can eat M&M's when the self-taught lesson is finished.
Materials	<p>A baggie or a 'fun-size' bag of M&M's for each child A Work Sheet for each child (unless you are working in groups)</p>
Preparation	<p>The paper. You can make up questions (here are a few of the from my work sheet) G=Green B=Blue R=Red Y=Yellow DB=Dark Brown O=Orange</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Without opening your bag guess how many M&M's are in your bag? 2. Now open your bag How many are really in there? 3. How many M&M's were you off by? 4. Put in groups. How many of each group are there? Green=_____ Blue=_____ Red=_____ Yellow=_____ Bark Brown=_____ 5. Now take 15 of the M&M's and put them in a pile.
Motivation	They will have a reward at the end of this lesson. Or you can tell them at the beginning of the week "if you are good we will do a fun project on (choose a day) this week!
Conclusion	They can share their answers because none (or most of them) will not have the same answers.
